How do I borrow books?

Bring the books you have chosen to the library desk and a member of the library staff will issue them to you. We do not use library cards so there is nothing else you need in order to borrow a book. Please do not lend your library book to a friend or leave it in a classroom.

How many books can I borrow?

You can borrow two books for a loan period of two weeks. The date is stamped inside the book so you know when to return it.

My book is due back but I'm still reading it. Can I renew it?

Come into the library and ask. Unless another student has requested it the book can be loaned for a further two weeks.

Where do I return books?

It's really important that you bring anything you have borrowed to the library desk. If a member of the library staff is not at the desk there is a red box on the counter to put returned books in. Please do not put books that you have borrowed back on the shelf.

How do I find out if the library has a particular book?

The library catalogue can be accessed through any computer in school. Click on the library catalogue icon on the desktop. Log in with your computer username and password.

A book I'd like to read is on loan. Can I reserve it?

Yes. Search for the book in the Library catalogue. From there you will be able to reserve it.

My books are overdue. What do I do?

Don't worry; there are no fines for overdue books. Come to the library desk. If you are still reading it the book can be renewed.

What do I do if I've lost a book?

Come to the library and speak to one of the library staff.
